Ideas for Fall

1. Homecoming Week

A great tradition at our school is Homecoming Week or Welcome Week. The week has homecoming couples, in each grade, sign up and then compete in daily competitions. Each team gets points based on their success each day and they culminate at the end of the week. Each point is equivalent to a vote. Then on the last day, which ends in a dance, people can vote for homecoming king or queen. By adding up the points and the votes we crown a homecoming king and queen in each grade.

To make the evening more eventful more memorable for the contestants, we have each couple pose and get pictures done in purple and gold attire. Also, each couple that participates in all events gets free tickets to the dance.

Below is a tentative schedule for each day:

MONDAY-INTRODUCTION OF COUPLES

This has always been done with a couples fashion show. Usually the theme is purple and gold attire, although we have also done an eighties theme once.

We have 3 guest teacher judges that try to play it up like the American Idol judges.

TUESDAY-THE NEWLYWED GAME

Have teams sit back to back and give each participant 4 placards (a, b, c, d).

Create quirky questions.

Have host ask question.

Contestants pick a letter.

Stand up.

Turn around and show partner.

Each team that gets it right gets a point.

WEDNESDAY-CHARITY COLLECTION

Each couple competes to get as much money as they can raise in one day. They can collect at school or in the community. In the past we have raised money for Big Brothers, the SPCA and the Men's Shelter.

THURSDAY-TALENT SHOW

Like Monday, get celebrity teacher judges. Then each couple showcases their unique skills to the judges and crowd.

Or

THURSDAY-DANCE OFF

Like Monday, get celebrity teacher judges. Then each couple showcases their sweet dance moves to the judges and crowd.

HOMECOMING DANCE

We have our dances on Thursday. As already explained, then each grade is crowned near the end of the night, mixing both points for each day with votes from the evening.

3. GRADE 10 ASSEMBLY (or the grade that joins your school)

One new thing we have added a couple years ago was a grade ten assembly. Below is a plan we used last year:

1. **Have a high school kids rock band playing live as grade 10 students come in.**
 - a. Hand out a Baron's t-shirt to each grade 10 student...thus every grade 10 has a piece of school clothing for spirit days
2. **Introduction of Administration and significant others.**
3. **Introduction of SRC Presidents.**
4. **Guys vs. Girls Competition (get volunteers from crowd)**
 - a. School Trivia
 - b. Prized to all who compete
5. **Show Grade 10 Documentary on the school rules**
 - a. 10 minute fun video that highlights rules like:
 - i. What Not to Wear
 - ii. How to Walk the Hallways
 - iii. No Hats
 - iv. No cell phones
 - v. How to use a library card
 - vi. Etc...
 - b. 5 minute video that highlights the clubs and sports grade 10's can join
6. **Have same band perform the school's rock anthem.**
7. **Free giveaways**
 - a. Have SRC members in each corner
 - b. Have MC say things like:
 - i. Whoever has a pink phone go to the far right corner
 - ii. Whoever has 20 bucks in their wallet go to front left
8. **Close assembly by inviting all students to go outside for free hotdogs and then go and join some clubs.** (Of course, have Club Rush during lunch that day...you will never have a better chance to build on the momentum).
